## THE GREAT TRAIN ROBBERY

On August 8, 1963 the night mail train was travelling from Glasgow to London, carrying letters, parcels, and 128 bags full of money. Suddenly the engine driver saw a red signal in an unusual place. As soon as he stopped, masked robbers entered the train. They moved the money bags into a lorry and made <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_\_. Within thirty minutes they had <sup>2</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ more than 2.5 million pounds.

The robbers had tied up the postal workers and ordered them <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ for half an hour. This suggested to the police that their hiding place was not far away. Nearly all of the gang members were arrested the same year and many were given severe jail <sup>5</sup> \_\_\_\_\_, but only a small part of the money was recovered. One of the robbers, Ronnie Biggs, escaped from prison and lived for many years in Brasil. As an old man he returned to England and was arrested, but was later released from prison because of his poor health.
